If you are mailing a DVD: **One video per disk.** Video disks with more than one film will be rejected.

- **Entries MUST be submitted for playback in DVD format**
 - o **DVD in NTSC format** (the common format for most DVD players in North America).
 - o **DVD must NOT include** menus or any formatting which do not allow direct playback upon disk load.
- All videos must be labeled with title, producer(s) name, category and total running time.

- Narrative:** Tell us a story, but make it quick! (3—5 minutes)
- Short Shorts:** Less than 60 seconds!
- Bermuda Shorts:** no longer than 10 minutes
